Work Search Requirement Will Be Reinstated for Federal Unemployment Insurance Claimants on July 18

The work search requirement will be reinstated for all federal Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) and Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) unemployment insurance claimants effective this Sunday, July 18. The work search requirement was already reinstated for regular state unemployment insurance claimants on Sunday, July 4.

To complete the work search requirement, unemployment insurance claimants must first register for an account with the state's job portal, the [Maryland Workforce Exchange \(MWE\)](#). The MWE is an online job and career services system that provides jobseekers with employment resources and access to job openings while simultaneously helping employers connect with qualified candidates.
