Deadline to Apply for Additional Disaster Relief Funds for Fisheries-Related Businesses by August 27

Maryland has allocated an additional \$3.4 million dollars in economic relief funds for the commercial seafood industry. Under CARES 2.0, direct payments will be provided to commercial, for hire, aquaculture, and seafood processing operations whose 2020 or 2021 revenue has suffered a loss of greater than 35% due to COVID-19.
